

**2009 Georgia National Junior Livestock
Banquet and Dance**

February 20, 2008 at 7:00 p.m.

The banquet will begin at 7:00 p.m. in the Miller-Murphy-Howard Building, Georgia National Fairgrounds & Agricenter.

Exhibitors (students who are actually exhibiting at the State Livestock Show in February or that exhibited in the State Market Lamb and Market Goat show in October) are eligible to order a complimentary banquet/dance ticket or a complimentary dance ticket.

Banquet tickets for parents, leaders, agents and teachers may be purchased for \$15.00. Tickets for non-participating children 5 to 8 years are available for \$6.00. Under 5 years old are admitted for free.

Attached is an order form for all tickets. This form is due to Heather K. Shultz, Hoke Smith Annex #321, Athens, GA 30602 no later than the close of business on **February 13th**. **Starting on February 9th please fax your ticket orders to us at 706/542-4373 to guarantee that we receive them before the deadline. Any additional adult or children tickets needed may be ordered now, but must be paid for when you pick up your tickets.** A **typed** list of all exhibitors' names for which you are requesting tickets must accompany the order form by February 13th with the school (FFA) or county (4-H) name on the top of the exhibitor list. Please include specie (Market Lamb, Market Goat, Market Steer, Market Hog, Breeding Beef Heifer and Commercial Dairy Heifer) showing for each exhibitor that is listed on the exhibitor list. We will not guarantee tickets will be sold after this date, nor can you reserve complimentary tickets after this date.

Tickets will be available for pick up by 4-H county or FFA chapter.

Please send **one** adult to pick up **ALL** county or chapter tickets. Tickets will not be handed out individually. The adult county or chapter representative will sign for the tickets and will be responsible to distribute tickets for the entire 4-H county or FFA chapter.

An exhibitor's dance will be held following the banquet in the Miller-Murphy-Howard Building. **For 2009: Exhibitors are strongly encouraged to attend the Awards Banquet, but we understand there are many activities going on during the week. The doors to the banquet will close promptly at 7:30 pm. To gain access to the Awards Banquet the exhibitors must have a Green Banquet/Dance Ticket. The doors will remain closed until the conclusion of the banquet and will re-open to allow exhibitors with a Blue Dance Only Ticket to enter the dance.** To provide a fun and secure atmosphere, no re-entrance is allowed. Once an individual leaves they will not be allowed back into the building.

Georgia Youth Livestock Show Youth Exhibitor Expectations

It is our desire to provide a safe, secure and fun environment for all exhibitors of the Georgia Junior National Livestock Banquet and Dance. To help provide this type of atmosphere we have provided certain expectations for those that will be attending the banquet and dance.

- As a representative of Georgia 4-H and FFA you are expected to present yourself in a positive manner and behave appropriately at all times.
- If at any time, that you do not meet these designated standards, you will be asked to leave the area immediately and will not be allowed to re-enter the banquet and dance.

Please remember that, as a registered exhibitor, you have submitted a signed copy of the Georgia Youth Livestock Show Code of Conduct. By signing the Code of Conduct, you, your parent/guardians, and your agents/agricultural education teachers, have agreed that you, the participant, will follow the Georgia Youth Livestock Show Code of Conduct at all times during the State Livestock Show, including the banquet and dance.

The following descriptions are provided to assist in defining the appropriate dress for the banquet and dance:

1. Shorts and skirts may be no more than three inches above the knee.
2. No backless shirts are allowed, this includes halter or tube tops. All shirts must be of a length that passes the waistband of pants, shorts or skirts with the midriff covered.
3. It is unacceptable for undergarments to be seen.
4. Pajama bottoms are not acceptable dress.
5. Hats are not to be worn inside the banquet hall.

NOTE: If a participant is asked to leave the banquet or dance due to an infraction of the Georgia Youth Livestock Code of Conduct or the provided Youth Expectations, the individual will be removed from the banquet and/or dance and will stay in a designated area with supervision until they are released to a supervising adult from their county/chapter.
