**Wednesday June 17, 2009**

- 4:00 p.m. Barn opens to accept cattle. Report to Beef Office to get stall assignments.  
8:00 p.m. Barn closes. Late arrivals must go to tie-outs.

**Thursday June 18, 2009**

- 7:00 a.m. Barn opens to accept cattle. Report to Beef Office to get stall assignments.  
A. Registered heifers need registration papers.  
B. Health papers will be checked.  
C. **No butt-fans or fans hung in a cage will be allowed. (AgriCenter Regulations).**  
Only hanging-type fans that are attached to tie panel in stalling area and cannot be attached by extension to hang beyond 42 inches from tie panel. **No dogs allowed in barn. Keep them at home.**  
D. Exhibitors need to pick-up complimentary Futurity t-shirts at show office.  
E. Bring your own straw to use in tie-outs. Cattle will be bedded on shavings in barn.  
1:00-3:00 p.m. Heifer & Steer Check in. Refer to Futurity rules and descriptive list of steers for additional information. **DNA Collection for the 2010 Georgia Junior National Livestock Steer Show will be held during Steer Check In.**  
2:00 p.m. -- Scholarship Contest participants should report to the Beef/Dairy Arena.  
3:00 p.m. -- All cattle must be in place and checked in.  
6:00 p.m. Opening Ceremony (all are required to attend, all activity in barn ceases)

10:00 – 3:00 Stockman's Quiz Contest – all exhibitors are invited to participate  
Showmanship continues by grade.  
12:00 noon **Lunch (on your own – show will not stop)**  
Showmanship continues  
Immediately following showmanship, presentation of Dan Daniel Scholarship, C.D. Brannen Memorial Scholarship, M.K. 'Curly' Cook Scholarship and Billy Moss Scholarship.
