ALL animals must be in the barn by 8 a.m, September 5, 2009

1. The meat goat show will consist of a doe and wether show. An overall show Grand Champion and Reserve Champion will be selected. Each child may enter up to 4 goats.
2. Showmanship will be divided into four divisions, and begins at 9 a.m. Saturday.
3. Each child may enter the "Dress Your Goat Contest." The goat "dressed" must be registered in the show.
 4. Minimum weight for the goats will be 35 lbs.
 5. The show is open to any breed or crossbreed.
6. Animals must have their milk teeth in normal position at the time of the show. Loss of one or both milk teeth will result in disqualification.
7. Current Georgia Health papers (no more than 4 months old) must be presented at check in.
 8. Horns must be tipped or removed.
 9. Animals will be shown by weight.
10. Rules for the meat goat show at the Georgia National Fair apply.

Animals must be registered in one of the following associations: ABGA, IBGA, USBGA or Canadian Boer Goat Association. **(ABGA no longer recognizes USBGA papers).** Animals under 3 months old and are entered on pending applications must show proof that the application has been submitted to one of the above associations. Registration papers must be originals, NO copies. The base date for computing ages for entries shall be the date of the show. Pens are assigned and cannot be changed. NO TACK PENS available—SORRY!
