

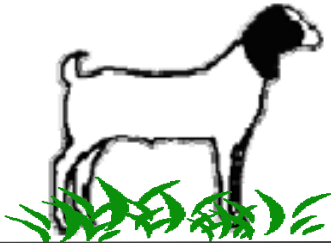

Market Goat Show

- ◆ All goats and lambs will be shown by weight
- ◆ Each exhibitor/owner must assume all liability in case of death or injury to his/her animal and any injury or death incurred by his/her animal
- ◆ Each goat and/or lamb must be accompanied by a valid set of Health Papers which are to be presented prior to unloading
- ◆ There will be no maximum number of entries per exhibitor
- ◆ There is a \$15.00 entry fee per head, \$5.00 entry for showmanship
- ◆ Checks payable to Purina Mills; Entry deadline is July 30th
- ◆ No refunds on pre-registrations; substitutions of a different animal or exhibitor will be accepted
- ◆ Late entries will be accepted up to check-in on August 14th; a \$10 late fee will be applied to each entry; ALL ENTRY FORMS MUST BE COMPLETE WITH SIGNATURE; use separate entry forms for each exhibitor
- ◆ Showmanship (3-4 classes) pay back to top 3 in each class
- ◆ Market classes (5-10 head per class) pay back to top 5 in each class
- ◆ Grand Champion Market Goat and Market Lamb—\$300 each
- ◆ Reserve Champion Market Goat and Market Lamb—\$150 each
- ◆ All exhibitors receive a bag of Purina Show Chow Honor Goat or Lamb Feed
- ◆ All premiums will be paid in cash after their respective show
- ◆ Shavings for bedding will be provided in livestock barn
- ◆ Owners are responsible for the care and clean-up of his/her own animal(s)
- ◆ Shavings for bedding will be provided in barn
- ◆ The owner is responsible for the care and clean-up of his/her own animal(s)
- ◆ Shearing and/or clipping must be done outside of barn, weather permitting
