**Eligible Participants and Rules**

1. All Georgia 4H and FFA members with currently enrolled hogs.
2. All other species (Being held the following day) are open only to Gordon County Youth 4H and FFA showman and/or Gordon County Young Farmer member's children. Gordon County Youth Showman whose parents are not Young Farmer members must pay an entry fee.
3. There will be a pee wee showmanship class for students under 9 years old for the hog show. Participants may show any animal that is currently in the Georgia Show Program.
4. There will be ONLY TWO major Divisions in Hog Classes
  - A. Market hogs-All barrows and exhibitor choice gilts
  - B. Breeding gilts-Exhibitor will declare a gilt to be breeding and all breeding gilts will be shown together regardless if it is of a purebred breed or commercial breeding gilt.
5. If possible, hog classes will be limited to 20 entries per class. All classes will be shown on Friday with approximately 5 classes per division. Class winners of each major division will be brought back at the end of their respective show for selection of Grand and Reserve Champion Market Hog or Grand and Reserve Champion Breeding Gilt.
6. Rules and regulations for 2010-2011 Hog program will be in effect that are not covered in these rules.
7. Health papers are required and animals must be Georgia tagged.

8. An exhibitor must show their own animal in the show. If an exhibitor has 2 animals that fall into the same class, another exhibitor, registered in the show must exhibit the extra animal.
9. The Gordon County Young Farmers Association or Gordon County Board of Commissioners WILL NOT be responsible for accidents to either the animals or the participants.
10. All entry forms must be signed by exhibitor, parent and county agent or advisor. Otherwise, they will not be accepted.
11. Any entry form will not be accepted if it is not accompanied by a check or cash.
12. Parents may join the Gordon County Young Farmers up until time of the show. For purposes of this show, a Gordon County Participant that is not required a entry fee is defined as follows:

*A member of the Gordon County 4H or FFA Program that's parent is currently a member of the Gordon County Young Farmers or a youth of another county show program that borders Gordon County and whose county is not served by a Young Farmer Program that's parent is currently a member of the Gordon County Young Farmers.*
