

**South Georgia/North Florida Meat Goat Show**  
**October 16, 2010**  
**Lowndes County Civic Center**  
**(2102 E. Hill Avenue, Valdosta, GA)**

1. **Eligibility:** The show will be open to all counties in Ga. And North FL. Classes are open to students, 4 -H and FFA members through the 12<sup>th</sup> grade (plus pre-club age children 3-6 years of age by October 1, 2010). Anyone who has been out of school for 6 months at the time of show is ineligible to participate.
2. This show is open to any breed or crossbred wether or doe – **NO BUCKS**.
3. **CLASS WEIGHT:** Goats will be weighed and divided into classes. **MINIMUM SHOW WEIGHT OF 35 POUNDS; Exception youth 3-6 years old.**
4. Goats must have milk teeth. We recommend that show goats be born after Jan. 1, 2010. Goats showing either or both of the first pair of the permanent incisors will not be able to show.
5. **NUMBER OF ENTRIES:** Each exhibitor may enter a maximum of **three** goats.
6. All goats must be dehorned or have horns tipped.
7. All goats must be tagged with some kind of identification number.
8. **SHOWMANSHIP:** Each exhibitor may show one goat in showmanship. The goat shown must be entered in the show by the exhibitor. **ENTRY FEE \$10 PER EXHIBITOR.**
9. **CLASSES:** Exhibitors must show their own goat. If an exhibitor has more than 1 goat in a class, they can have another exhibitor show goats for them. This must be cleared with show officials before the show starts.
10. **ENTRY FEE: \$ 10 PER ANIMAL.** All entry fees will be used for prize and show expenses.
11. **HEALTH PAPERS:** Certificate of Veterinary inspection with the following statement must be shown. All animals should be listed separately. ***“no evidence of foot rot, scabies, sore mouth, or cutaneous fungal disease”***. All Does should also have a Scrapie Tag. It is recommended that all goats have a Scrapie tag.
12. **ENTRY DEADLINE:** As Late As October 16, 2010; ***Limited to first 80 goats***
