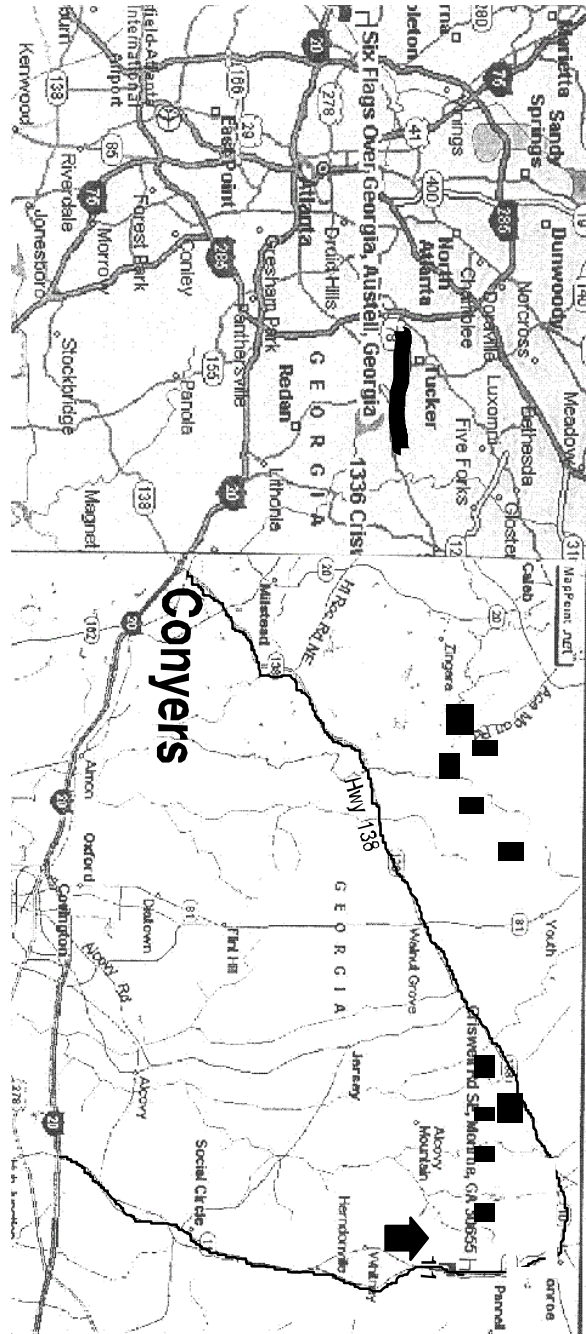

From Atlanta take I-20 to Conyers, turn left on Hwy 138 (north) to Monroe (25 miles), turn right on Spring St. -Hwy 10, at the courthouse turn right on Broad St. -Hwy 11, go approximately 3 miles, turn right on Criswell Rd., one half mile on right is Ag. Center.
Or you can take Hwy 78 from Atlanta to Monroe, turn right on Hwy 11, go approximately 5 miles to Criswell Rd., one half mile on right to Ag. Center.

Youth Market Meat Goat Show

1. ELIGIBILITY: Entries are open to youth 18 or under. Animals entered in the Market Meat Goat Show are not eligible to show in the Breeding Boer Goat Show.
2. This show is open to any breed or crossbred wether or doe.
3. **Goats will be weighed by show officials on Saturday, May 21, from 8 a.m. to 11 a.m.** Goats will then be divided into eight to twelve (8-12) weight classes as equal in number as possible. (Number of Classes may vary depending on the number of entries and the show officials' discretion.)
4. All goats must be carrying all milk teeth at time of weigh-in. Goats showing either or both of the first pair of permanent incisors will not be eligible to show.
5. All goats must be dehorned or have horns tipped.
6. **Bracing of the goats will not be permitted for this show.**
7. Entry Fee: \$10.00 per entry and \$5.00 per pen, includes first bedding.
Late fee of \$5 will be charged for entries postmarked after May 13, 2011 for Market Meat Show.

SHOWMANSHIP

Exhibitors age (6 to 19) from both the Market Meat Goat Show and Boer Goat Open Show are eligible to participate in the Showmanship Class. Animals exhibited in showmanship must also be entered in either the Market Meat Goat weight classes or the Breeding Boer Goat classes and must be owned by the exhibitor.

Note; All goats in showmanship must carry their milk teeth.

BREEDING BOER GOAT SHOW

Boer Goats must be checked in with Superintendent at the barn by Friday, May 20, 2011, 8:00 p.m.

1. Entries: There is no limit to the number of animals an exhibitor may enter in the Breeding Boer Goat Show. All entries must be postmarked by May 13, 2011 and the entry fee of \$15.00 per goat and \$5.00 per pen (first bedding included) must accompany the entry form. No straw, sand or other material will be allowed in the barn.

LATE ENTRIES postmarked (after May 13) will be \$20.00 per entry.

2. Registration: All goats six months or older must be registered with The International Boer Goat Association, American Boer Goat Association, Canadian Boer Goat Association or USBGA. Original registration papers must be shown to the superintendent at check in. No copies will be accepted. Animals under six months of age must have a stamped duplicate or faxed duplicate application showing date received by The International Boer Goat Association, ABGA, CBGA or USBGA offices.

3. Eligibility: Animals entered in the Market Meat Goat Show are not eligible to show in the Breeding Boer Goat Show. Otherwise, the show is open to the world.

4. Ownership: Proof of ownership shall be the name on the registration document. Persons showing animals whose registration certificates have signed transfer that have not been processed by The International Boer Goat Association, ABGA, CBGA or USBGA offices must show these animals as agent for the owner on record.

5. Classes: Animals will be shown by age according to the registration certificate. Management reserves the right to combine or split classes.

6. Grand Champions will be chosen from the first place animals in the preceding individual classes. Reserve Grand Champion will be selected from the remaining first place animals plus the second place winner from the individual class from which the Grand Champion was chosen.

7. Identification: All goats must have I.D. (i.e. ear tag, tattoo, micro-chip (bring microchip reading device) and this I.D. must match the registration papers of said goat at the time of check-in and I.D. must be included on the entry form.
