Overview

World Leaders provide the first official welcome to all new and transfer international students attending the University of Georgia. This group of student volunteers helps international students prepare for a successful beginning on campus. The World Leader program provides a unique opportunity to have a positive impact on newly admitted international students while also developing leadership, communication, and teamwork skills. World Leaders will work closely with International Student Life staff to ensure a successful orientation week. The opportunity to work closely on a team with a select group of fellow student leaders is the most challenging and potentially rewarding aspect of the World Leaders experience. Additionally, being a World Leader requires a significant time commitment. **Applicants MUST be available July 30th-31st for training AND August 1st-8th for the international orientation week.**

Responsibilities include (but are not limited to):

- Participate in MANDATORY two-day training program (July 30-31)
- Participate in the orientation week and subsequent orientation-related activities from August 1 – August 8
- Assist new international students with settling into life in Athens/UGA

Selection Process

The selection process will consist of an individual interview and a thorough review of application materials. Applicants must sign up for an interview time when they turn in their application. Selection of applicants will be based on their application as well as their interview.
