RULES –

- The shows are open to the following counties – Bartow, Carroll, Catoosa, Chattooga, Cherokee, Clayton, Cobb, Coweta, Dade, Dawson, Dekalb, Douglas, Fannin, Fayette, Floyd, Forsyth, Fulton, Gilmer, Gordon, Haralson, Heard, Henry, Murray, Paulding, Pickens, Polk, Walker, and Whitfield.
- To finance the shows, a \$10 per lamb entry fee will be charged. **All money is due at the time of entry deadline (July 25<sup>th</sup>) and checks should be made payable to Gordon County 4-H. Do not send cash.** Premiums will be based on the amount of entries received. Grand Champions will receive \$150.00 and a belt buckle; Reserve Champions will receive \$100.00 and a belt buckle.
- Market classes are open only to 4-H and FFA members including pre-club youth in grades 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> who have owned their animal since June 1, 2011. Pee-wee youth can show in classes, but must own and be able to control/lead their animals.
- Entry forms and fees are due Monday, July 25, 2011 and should be mailed to Gordon County 4-H, Lamb Show, 1 McDaniel Station Road, SW, Calhoun, Georgia 30701.
- The barn will be open on Friday, August 5, 2011. Check-in starts at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, August 6, 2011 with the show beginning at 10:00 a.m. Have lambs freshly sheared (no more than two weeks growth). All lambs will be inspected for Club Lamb Fungus and Sore Mouth before weigh-in by a veterinarian from the State Department of Agriculture. Current health papers must be made available upon request.
- An exhibitor can show as many lambs as desired, but each exhibitor cannot show more than two (2) animals in the same weight class.
- Entries must be wether or ewe lambs (no rams will be allowed).
- All entries must be trained for showing.

RULES – Continued

- Shearing and/or clipping must be done outside of barn, weather permitting
- All lamb entries must have their tails docked.
- There will be no minimum weight required. **No re-weighing after lamb has left scale area.**
- The show committee reserves the right to mouth animals if there's a question of age.
- Exhibitors must show his/her animals in all classes unless permission is otherwise given by the show committee. Exhibitors must show their own animal in showmanship – no exceptions.
- All animals must have an identification number.
- Decisions made by the show committee regarding rules and regulations are **FINAL**.
- Since space is limited, all participants will be assigned pens for their animals.
- **Pre-registration is required for ALL Showmanship (entry deadline is July 25<sup>th</sup>). Showmanship entry fee is \$5.00 per exhibitor. Due to planning for awards, do not ask to participate in the showmanship class on the day of the show.** There will be a showmanship class for Pee-Wee youth below first grade. Pee-Wee exhibitors showing in showmanship class may borrow a lamb and are not required to pay the \$5.00 entry fee.
- Exhibitors are encouraged to show their lambs shorn slick.
- **Entry fees are NON-REFUNDABLE**
