Check-in will be from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. Friday afternoon and 7 a.m. to 9 a.m. Saturday morning. Show will begin Saturday morning at 9:30 a.m. with showmanship classes. State Show rules apply and the show committee has the right to make any necessary changes.

Entries are due (postmarked) by October 10, 2012. Entry fees of \$20 per animal for current Georgia Farm Bureau Members and \$30 per animal for non-members. Membership can be obtained at your local county Farm Bureau Office for \$25. Show is open only to Junior Beef Cattle exhibitors of the counties listed above.
