**Gordon County Young Farmers Livestock Show Rules and Regulations**

1. **Eligibility:** All Swine Classes will be open to **all** eligible FFA and 4H members.
2. **Rules and Regulations for the 2012-2013 Georgia State Livestock Show will be in effect.**
3. **Fees:** Entry fees will be \$25 per animal. Entry deadline is December 15, 2012. Showmanship entry fee will be \$5 per animal.
4. **Drugs and Diuretics:** Administration of any drug of any kind or description internally or externally is prohibited, except for treating a recognized disease or injury as prescribed by a licensed veterinarian. For the purpose of these rules the term "drug" shall mean: any substance, the sale, possession or use of which is controlled by license under federal, state or local laws or regulations and any substance commonly used by the medical or veterinary professions which affect circulatory, respiratory or central nervous systems of an animal to include diuretics. The use of any diuretic for any purpose whatsoever on any animal in the show is prohibited. Show management reserves the right to take blood and/or urine samples for analysis. Any violators will be reported to the appropriate state and federal authorities.
5. An official health certificate as required by Georgia Department of Agriculture regulations must accompany steers and heifers. (Refer to 2012-2013 Georgia 4-H and FFA rules and regulations booklet for details.)
6. The decision of the judge and other show officials will be final.
7. All exhibitors participating in showmanship must show their own animal. Exhibitors in showmanship will not be allowed to change their animal once the showmanship class starts.
8. There will be a Novice showmanship for those individuals who have **never** shown an animal before. There is no entry fee for the Novice showmanship class and animals will be provided on site.
9. This will be a non-terminal show.
10. There will be a Gilt show and Barrow show.
11. There is no minimum weight for prospect hogs, maximum weight for prospect hogs is 200lbs.
12. All hogs must be owned by exhibitors and be ear tagged. However the tag **does not** need to be a Georgia State Ear Tag.

**13.** No clipping of hogs will be allowed at the arena. All hogs will need to be clipped prior to their arrival on grounds and check-in.
