- Entry fee is \$15 per goat; \$5 per exhibitor for showmanship; all entries must be postmarked by JULY 24<sup>TH</sup>, 2013 to avoid a late fee of \$10 per goat and an additional \$5 per exhibitor for showmanship; entries will be taken up to check-in
- No entries should be mailed after July 24<sup>th</sup>, cash payments at check-in only if late.
- **All goats must be this year's project**

- Showmanship will begin 15 minutes after the N.W.GA Lamb Classic.

### RULES

1. The show is open to any Georgia 4-H or FFA exhibitor. Graduated seniors are eligible for market show but not showmanship.
2. Only wethers and does may be shown....NO BUCKS.
3. All goats will be shown as market goats.
4. Goats will be weighed and divided into classes by show committee; there will be no re-weigh after the goat leaves the scales. There are no weight limits.
5. Entry fee is \$15 per goat (\$25 per goat after August 1<sup>st</sup>) with no limit on the number of entries per exhibitor.
6. Showmanship entry fee is \$5.00 per exhibitor (\$10 per exhibitor after August 1<sup>st</sup>)
7. All goats must be EAR TAGGED with a number that corresponds with the number on the entry form. Ear tags must be readable.
8. Goats must have milk teeth; we recommend goats be born after January 1, 2013.
9. An official Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (Health Certificate) with the individual animal identification number is required to show.
10. No refunds will be given after August 1<sup>st</sup>; substitutions of a different animal or exhibitor will be accepted.
11. Payout of market and showmanship classes will be based on the availability of funds and the number of goats entered in the show.
12. All premiums will be paid in cash after their respective class.
13. There will **not be a rule on bracing**.
14. The owner is responsible for the care and clean-up of his/her own goat(s).
15. Shavings for bedding will be provided in the barn.



Rules – continued

Showmanship Classes:

Exhibitors will be classified based on grade level as of August 2013 as follows: (Graduated seniors are not eligible for showmanship)

- Grades 1 – 2
- Grades 3 – 4
- Grades 5 – 6
- Grades 7 – 8
- Grades 9 – 12

Pay Out:

- Grand Champion - \$300
- Reserve Champion - \$150
- Showmanship – Top 3 placements per class
- Market Classes – Top 5 placements per class
