We will hold a "Old Timers show" this will be a quick show of parents, guardians or grandparents of participants who will be nominated by their kids/grandkids to show their goats in a showmanship competition for a nominal fee to be collected at show. You can opt out by paying a small fee. All in fun!

There will be **NO BRACING OF ANY FORM OR FASHION.** All rules will be followed or participants will be disqualified. We want to have a nice, clean family oriented show.

RULES

1. The show is open to any 4-H or FFA member from ANY STATE. Minimum age is six (6) years old and in the first grade by September 1, 2014. Maximum age is eighteen (18) years old. Pee Wee showmanship is open to any child under (6) yrs. Old.
2. **All participants and their parents must adhere to the code of conduct set forth by FFA & 4-H**
3. Only wethers and does may be shown...NO BUCKS. Open to any breed or crossbred wether or doe.
4. All animals will be shown as market animals, must be slick shorn and be dehorned or have horns tipped.
5. Goats will be weighed and divided into classes by show committee. There will be no reweighs after the goat leaves the scales. There are no weight limits.
6. Entry fee is \$20 per goat with no limit on the number of entries per exhibitor. No fee for Pee Wee Showmanship.
7. Exhibitors **MUST SHOW THEIR OWN GOATS IN CLASS.** If an exhibitor has more than one goat in a class, another exhibitor may show for them with approval of the show committee.
8. Showmanship entry fee is \$5.00 per exhibitor. Each exhibitor must show his or her own animal in showmanship. That animal must be entered in the show and be owned by the exhibitor (exception is Pee Wee showmanship). You may show in weight class without participating in showmanship, but you may not participate in showmanship without showing in weight class (exception is Pee Wee showmanship).
9. All goats must be **EAR TAGGED OR TATTOOED** with a number that corresponds with the number on the entry form. Ear tags and tattoos must be readable.
10. Goats must have milk teeth. Any goat showing evidence of permanent incisors will not be allowed to show. We recommend goats be born after Jan. 1, 2014. Show officials will check is animal's age is in question.
11. An Official Certificate of Veterinary Inspection with the individual animal identification number is required to show. **ALL DOES MUST HAVE A USDA APPROVED SCRAPIE TAG IN THE EAR.**
12. Absolutely no refunds will be given.
13. **NO ADULTS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE RING OTHER THAN THE JUDGE AND THE SHOW COMMITTEE OR ITS' REPRESENTATIVES.** (Exceptions is Pee Wee showmanship)
14. Does and Wethers will be shown separate. The number of classes will be determined based on number of entries and will be at the discretion of show officials.
15. Every effort is being made to provide enough pens; they will be on a first come first serve basis. If we do not have enough pens you will be allowed to trailer your goat. There will be special parking for this purpose. Bedding will be provided. Owners are responsible for the care and clean up of his/her animal. Power is always an issue at shows best to come all clipped and ready to show.
16. Any protest must be presented to the show committee in writing and be accompanied by a nonrefundable \$50 cash deposit.
17. **Bracing will not allowed of any form or fashion. This will be enforced.**
18. Each exhibitor/owner assumes all liability in case of death or injury to his/her animal and any injury or death incurred by his/her animal. Habersham Co. FFA Alumni assumes no liability for loss or damage to property.
19. Sponsors reserve the right to close the registration period prior to deadline if necessary.
20. Inhumane or abusive treatment of animals may result in disqualification at the discretion of the show management
