*2014 Gordon County Young Farmers Goat Classic  
Calhoun/Gordon County Livestock Pavilion  
August 3, 2014 - Rules & Regulations*

1. *The show will be open to all youth that are not 6 months past graduation and younger.*
2. *This show is open to any registered or crossbred wether or doe.*
3. *Goats will be weighed and divided into classes. There will be a **market** wether show and a **market** doe show. Goats must meet a minimum of 20lbs. Goats not making minimum weight will be sifted from the show and returned to the exhibitor. No entry fee refund will be given for goats that are sifted from the show.*
4. *Goats must have their milk teeth. Goats showing either or both of the first pair of the permanent incisors will not be able to show.*
5. *All goats must be dehorned or have horns tipped.*
6. *Each exhibitor may show one goat in showmanship. The goat must be entered in the show and entered by the exhibitor. There is no entry fee for showmanship but you must preregister on your entry form.*
7. *Only show officials and exhibitors allowed in the show ring.*
8. *Entry fees are \$20.00 per goat. No showmanship fee.*
9. *Exhibitors may be prepared to pen in their trailers.*
10. *All goats must have an official health certificate (health paper) according to State Department of Agriculture Health Regulations.*
11. *Entry fees are non-refundable*
12. *GGPPA Points will be given to those eligible.*
13. *State rules apply.*

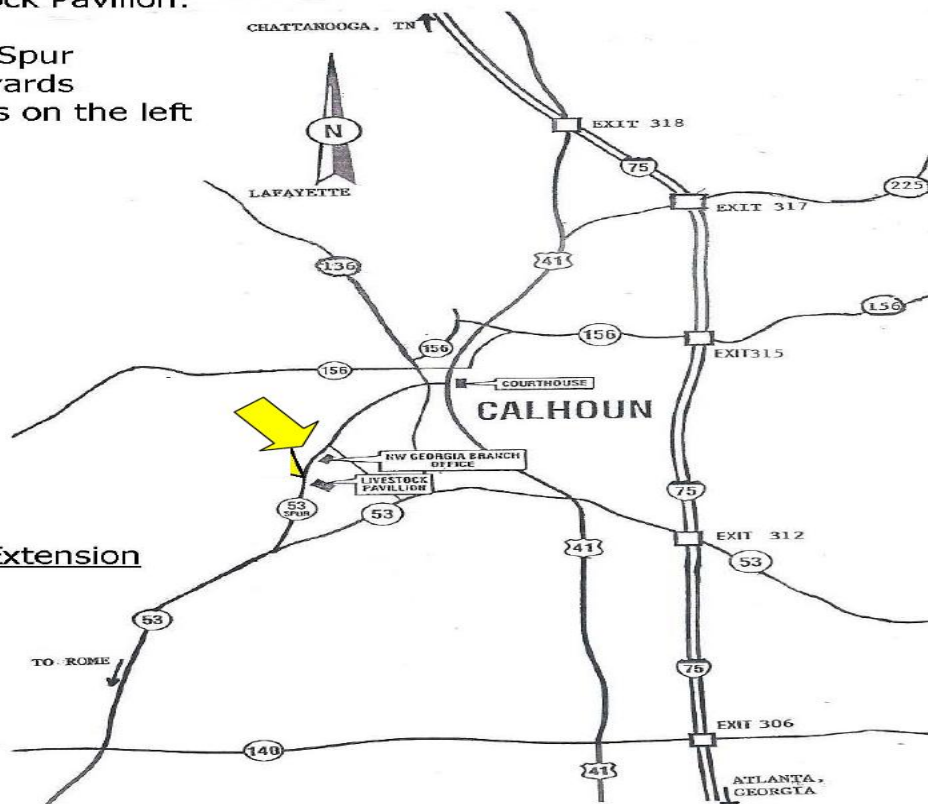
Directions to Gordon County Cooperative Extension,

From Exit 312 off of I-75:

- Take Highway 53 West approximately 2 miles
- Turn right on McDaniel Station Road
- The Gordon County Cooperative Extension and Northwest Georgia Research and Education office is the last building on your left prior to the stop sign

To Continue on to the Livestock Pavilion:

- Travel to the stop sign
- Turn left on to Hwy 53 Spur
- Go approximately 200 yards
- The Livestock Pavilion is on the left
