then the show will be split.

1st Annual Georgia Elite Jackpot

1. The show is open to 4-H and FFA members. All 4-H and FFA members through the 12th grade (plus pre-club age children in grades K-4) may show.
2. **All Gwinnett County Fair Rules and Regulations will be followed. Exception is there is no limit on the number of goats you can enter, whereas, the Gwinnett County Fair you are allowed to show two and this show will allow bracing.**
3. Only wethers and does allowed. NO BUCKS. All animals will be shown as market.
4. Goats will be weighed and divided into classes of at least ten goats per class by show officials. We will use weights from Gwinnett County Fair.
5. Classes: Exhibitors must show their own goat in class. If the exhibitor has more than one goat in class they can have another exhibitor show for them. This must be cleared with show officials before showing.
6. Does and wethers will show together unless we have 75 of each sex. If 75 of each sex we will have a split show.
7. All goats must be dehorned or have horns tipped.
8. All goats must be properly ear tagged.
9. **Entry Fee: The entry per animal is \$50.** Late entries will be **\$75.00 cash** only if received after September 1.
10. Payouts will be for the following:
Only the Overall Top 5 Will Receive Prize Money
11. Goats must have milk teeth. Goats showing evidence of any of their permanent incisors will not be allowed to show.
12. A certificate of Veterinary Inspection is required with the individual identification and the following statement: **Flock of origin is free from Foot Rot, Scabies, Contagious Ecthyma(soremouth), Cutaneous Fungal Lesions, Scrapie or any other Infectious disease.** All Does must have a USDA approved scrapie tag in the ear. **Registration numbers will not serve as the scrapie tag for the show.**
13. The Georgia Elite Jackpot Show Committee reserves the right to review the rules and make changes if necessary. All decisions made by the Georgia Elite Jackpot Show Committee are final.
14. Absolutely no refunds will be given.
15. There are no weight limits.

16. The Georgia Elite Jackpot Show Committee and the Gwinnett County Fair accepts no responsibility nor assumes any risk for injury to the exhibitor or animal due to or resulting from participation in the Georgia Elite Jackpot Show.
