JR BEEF HEIFER SHOW GENERAL INFORMATION SERVICES

Everyone who enters the fairgrounds must pay either daily fair admission or purchase a livestock exhibitor pass. Both will be available at the livestock gate. Exhibitor passes can be purchased in advance. If purchased in advance they will be available for pick up at the livestock gate. The GEORGIA STATE FAIR is held at the Atlanta Motor Speedway in Hampton, GA.

Adult Admission- \$10

Child Admission- \$5

Exhibitor Pass- \$10

Bedding- No shavings will be provided in stalls. Exhibitors can bring their own bedding or purchase shavings on the grounds for \$7 per bag. No straw allowed in tents.

Lost Articles- Report and recover lost and found articles at the Show Office.

First Aid- First aid station will be located on the Fairgrounds.

Restrooms- Restroom facilities are provided throughout the grounds.

Official Veterinarian- The management will appoint an Official Veterinarian and such other assistants as may be necessary. The Veterinarian in charge will be available in case of sickness of any animal to take charge and advise treatment of same. A reasonable charge will be made upon the owner of such service.
