2014 Post Card Art Contest

Open to K-12 grade students

Work must be completed at school and mailed by your school to ensure it is designed and made by the student. The contest is sponsored by the Jimmy Carter NHS Education Program. Winning entries from previous years are posted online under **In the Spotlight** at www.jimmycarter.info.

Theme : The student's design should reflect this year's theme: **Celebrating 90 Years**. Each entry must include at least one peanut. The art work must be original student work. No copyright /trademarks can be used.

Contest Rules and Directions

1. All entries must be received no later than Friday, September 12 by 5:00PM.
2. Entries must be on white unruled 3x5 or 4x6 index cards or card stock.
3. Art work may be paint, ink, pastel, crayon, marker or pencil.
4. Finished card must be flat and include at least 1 peanut.
 - A. Students are encouraged to be creative and include art work reflecting Plains, farming, President Carter's political career and/or the Carter's work through the Carter Center in Atlanta (www.cartercenter.org)
 - B. Each card must have the following contact information on the back of the card:(Please print)
Student name, grade level, teacher's name, school name, school phone number & school fax number
5. Teachers must bundle their cards together by grade level and include a cover sheet per bundle with this information: **Teacher's name, school & mailing address, grade, e-mail and phone number.**
6. Mail entries to Annette Wise, 300 North Bond Street, Plains, Georgia 31780.
7. Winners will be notified through their school by September 17th.
8. Entries become the property of the Education Program and will not be returned.
9. Cards will be judged on creativity and neatness.

Awards: Each grade level will have a winner and runner up. They will be invited to an awards ceremony on September 27, 2014 in Plains. President Carter is scheduled to present certificates to each winner.
