Rules and Regulations

- All animals being exhibited in any type of livestock show (local, county, area, district or state) must have an official certificate of veterinary inspection (health certificate). This certificate of veterinary inspection must be issued within 30 days of the exhibition - with the exception of 4-H and FFA shows. See the current year Georgia 4-H and FFA State Livestock Shows Rules and Regulations for specific information for 4-H and FFA health certificates. All other livestock exhibitors must follow rules and regulations as outlined in the "Health Requirement for Exhibition of Livestock in Georgia," revised October 7, 2003, from the Georgia Department of Agriculture. No animals will be allowed entry to the show without the proper health records and test requirements.
- Exhibitors must be actively participating in a swine project and must be the owner of the animal.
- An exhibitor may enter three hogs to show, but may not have more than two entries in any one class in competition for prize money.
- Each exhibitor must furnish their own animals' feed, feed pan, water pail and show supplies. The livestock pavilion will furnish the bedding, electric power and water.
- It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to feed, water, clean-up after and provide general care of their animals while on property.
- Veterinarian service for animals while on property is at the owner's expense.
- Neither the Northwest Georgia Research & Education Livestock Pavilion, University of Georgia, Gordon County Extension, Gordon County 4-H, Gordon County, Georgia nor any of its employees are responsible for loss or damage to any animal and will give attention to prevent loss or damage.
- We shall honor the Statement of Relation (Memorandum of Understanding) between Vocational Education and the Cooperative Extension which is considered the official agreement. This agreement guides 4-H and FFA participation in events. The intent of the agreement is to support youth participating in both organizations with different project areas and to disallow a young person competing in both organizations with the same project area in the same year.
- No clipping of hogs will be allowed on property. All hogs will need to be clipped prior to their arrival.

- **Entry form must be in the hands of Gordon County 4-H no later than Friday, January 9, 2015. Any and all entry forms received after 5:00 p.m. on that date will NOT be accepted for participation.**
- Entry form is not to be faxed or emailed to Gordon County 4-H; payment must accompany entry.
- Entry fees are non-refundable.
- Mail completed entry form with payment to Gordon County 4-H - Jackpot Swine Show - 1282 Highway 53, Spur, SW - Suite 200 - Calhoun, Georgia 30701.
- Show committee members are Allie Griner - Extension Agent, Gordon County 4-H and Kurt Sutherland - Youth Livestock Coordinator - Gordon County 4-H.
- The show committee reserves the right to disqualify any animal on the basis of health concerns.
- Barrows and gilts will be shown separately by weight.
- Premiums will be based on entries received.
- All premiums will be paid by check from Gordon County 4-H at the end of the show.

Showmanship Classes:

Swine showmanship classes will be separated by grade in school. Showmanship will start with lowest grade level entered and go up. The exhibitor may show any one of his/her entries in the showmanship contest. Any market hog which is removed for any reason from the show cannot be shown in showmanship.

Market Classes:

Entries will be divided by weight into as approximately equal classes as possible. Dividing hogs into classes will be left up to the discretion of the show committee. If possible, classes will be limited to 10 entries per class.
