Andy Paul, a member of the Oglethorpe County FFA chapter, is the 15th Georgian to be elected to serve as a National FFA Officer, and only the third from Georgia to serve as National FFA President. Andy was elected at the 87th National FFA Convention in Louisville, Kentucky. Andy and his teammates spent two weeks in Japan in January, and this spring will be traveling the country attending State FFA Conventions.

Andy is a 2013 graduate of Oglethorpe County High School. As an FFA member, Andy developed a swine production SAE, and he served as chapter President, competed in the Livestock Judging and Discussion Meet CDEs. In 2013-14, Andy served State FFA President. Andy is taking a one year leave of absence from ABAC, where he is a sophomore, to travel as a national officer. He is majoring in Agricultural Education.

Andy will speak at the 4th General Session at 2:30 p.m. on Friday, April 24.
