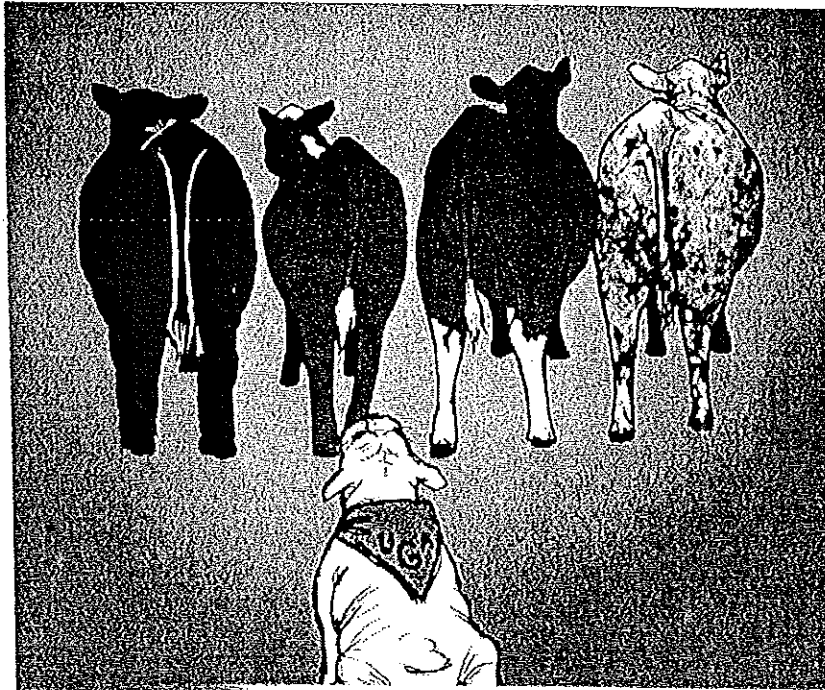


2015 Georgia Livestock Clinic
