Labor Day Classic Goat Show September 4 & 5, 2015 Rules and Regulations

- 1. The show will be open to all counties in Ga. Classes are open to 4-H and FFA members through the 12th grade (plus pre club age children in grades K-4 and at least 5yrs of age by Sept 1.)
- 2. This show is open to all breeds or crossbred wether or doe.
- 3. Goats will be weighed and divided into classes. There will be a wether show and a market doe show.
- 4. Goats must have their milk teeth. Goats that have either or both of the first pair of the permanent incisors will not be able to show.
- 5. Each exhibitor may enter a maximum of five goats
- 6. All goats must be dehorned or have horns tipped. .
- 7. All goats must have a tag.
- 8. Each exhibitor may show one goat in showmanship. The goat shown must be entered in the show and owned and entered by the exhibitor.
- 9. Only show officials and exhibitors are allowed in the show ring.
- 10. Entry fees are \$25.00 per goat. Entry fees are non-refundable.
- 11. There will be a pen fee of \$8.00 per pen. You may have as Purchase as many pens as you need. Pen **fees** are non-refundable.
- 12. The goats must have an official health certificate (health paper), according to State Department of Agriculture Health Regulations.
- 13. Entry deadline line is <u>August 21, 2015</u>. After August 21, entry fees are \$35.00 per goat. Late entry **fees** are non-refundable.

- 16. These rules are in addition to the 2015 State Goat Show Rules.
