Show will begin Saturday morning at 9:30 a.m. with showmanship classes. State Show rules apply and the show committee has the right to make any changes. This is a no-fit show.

Entries are due (postmarked) by December 18, 2015. ENTRY FEE: Farm Bureau Members - \$25 Per Animal, Non-Members - \$35 Per Animal. Membership can be obtained at your local County Farm Bureau office for \$25. Show is open only to Junior Beef Cattle exhibitors of the counties listed above.
