

General Rules

- 1) All animals must be checked in and weighed prior to 9:30 am Saturday, February 13, 2016.
- 2) There will be no reweighs after the hogs leave the scale area. All exhibitors questioning weights should voice concern at the time the animal's weight is announced.
- 3) Any exhibitor 19 years old or younger who has not completed high school is eligible to show. All exhibitors must be able to exhibit his/her animal without the assistance of an adult or older exhibitor in the ring.
- 4) All exhibitors must maintain continuous full ownership, possession and provide primary care for their animal project.
- 5) Each exhibitor must show his/her own animal unless the exhibitor has more than one in the same class.
- 6) All animal projects will be shown at the owner's own risk. Each exhibitor must assume responsibility in the case of death or injury.
- 7) Exhibitors must keep the part of the building they occupy neat and attractive in appearance. ALL PENS MUST BE CLEANED PRIOR TO LEAVING THE SHOW.
- 8) Pigs will be penned 2 pigs per pen. Bring a divider if you need one. Pens will be available on a first come first serve basis. Bedding will be provided for each pen. Be prepared to show off your trailer if needed.
- 9) Because of limited space, tack pens are not available.
- 10) All animals must have current health papers at time of unloading. All animals must be PRV and Brucellosis negative and have an official health certificate.
- 11) No clipping of pigs at the show.
- 12) No limit to the number of animals you can show.
- 13) All animals must have a clean, readable ear tag.
- 14) Showmanship classes: Pre- Club (pre-k -5th grade), Junior (6th - 8th grades), Intermediate (9th - 10th grades), and Senior (11th and 12th grades)
- 15) Classes will be split based on weight.
- 16) Barrows and gilts will show together in classes.
- 17) All show premiums will be paid in cash following the class. Prize money/ awards will be given to the top 3 pigs in each class, grand champion, reserve grand champion, and the champion showman from each class of showmanship.
- 18) The judge's decision is final in all classes.
- 19) Show officials reserve the right to make changes deemed to be in the best interest of the show.
- 20) No alcoholic beverages allowed on the grounds during the show.
- 21) No tobacco products or smokeless tobacco products allowed in the barn and show ring areas.
