# **2016 RULES AND REGULATIONS**

## **71<sup>st</sup> WEST CENTRAL GEORGIA STEER AND HEIFER SHOW**

**PARTICIPANTS:** Open show for all 4-H and FFA members in Georgia. They must be at least 9 years of age according to Georgia Show Rules. Anyone that has been out of high school six months is not eligible to compete.

**ELIGIBILITY FOR ENTERING:** Any of the above youth desiring to enter the 2016 show may do so as long as they follow qualifications listed below and are certified by their County Agent or Vocational Instructor. **ALL animals must be accompanied by official health papers.**

1. The West Central Georgia Steer and Heifer Show will be held on Saturday, January 30, 2016 at 12:00 pm at the Upson-Lee AG Center in Thomaston, Georgia. In the event the show has to be postponed, it will be held as soon as possible.
2. **All entry forms must be postmarked, faxed, or received by January 20, 2016** and entry fee of \$25 per animal must accompany the signed form.

  - Make checks payable to West Central Georgia Steer and Heifer Show. If you have any questions call Upson County Extension Office 706-647-8989.
3. The Grand Champion Steer will receive \$500.00 and Reserve Champion Steer \$300.00. The Grand Champion Heifer will receive \$500.00 and Reserve Champion Heifer will receive \$300.00.
4. **It is a “blow and go show” with no adhesives allowed.**
5. Steers and heifers will be accepted at the Upson-Lee AG Show Barn on Saturday, January 30, 2016. All calves must be on the property and checked in by 10:00 am. Weighing will start at 9:30 am.
6. Each steer/heifer entered must be owned, cared for and fed by the contestant and entered in the Georgia State 4-H & FFA Show.

### **STEER QUALIFICATIONS:**

- The 2016 minimum weight for steers will be 700 lbs. Show steer calves must be of beef conformation, dehorned, show caliber, and halter broken.
- Steers must have been born on or after August 1, 2014.

- Steers will be shown by weight. Classes will be divided as evenly into classes as possible, but final division will be left to the discretion of the Classification Committee. Steers will be lined up by weight.

#### HEIFER QUALIFICATIONS:

- Heifers must be the sole property of the exhibitor. A registered heifer must be accompanied by **original registration certificates** at the time heifers are checked in the show. If papers are not presented at check in, they will be disqualified and they cannot drop to the Commercial Class.
- Heifers from horned breeds may be shown with horns.

#### CLASSIFICATION OF COMMERCIAL HEIFERS:

- Commercial heifers should be born on or after January 1, 2014.
- Commercial heifers will be divided into Senior heifers (born before August 31, 2014) and Junior heifers (Born after September 1, 2014). Classes within each group will be broken by weight.

#### CLASSIFICATION OF REGISTERED HEIFERS:

- Class I - Junior heifer calves born after January 1, 2015 and after.
  - Class II - Winter heifer calves born November 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014.
  - Class III - Senior heifer born September 1, 2014 through October 31, 2014.
  - Class IV - Summer Heifers born July 1, 2014 through August 31, 2014.
  - Class V - Spring Yearling born April 1, 2014 through June 31, 2014.
  - Class VI - Junior Yearling born January 1, 2014 through March 31, 2014.
- The first and second place heifers in each class will compete for Champion and Reserve Champion of the respective breed and commercial division. Supreme Champion and Reserve Champion Heifers will be selected from breed and commercial champions.
7. **SHOWMANSHIP:** Senior, Junior, Novice, and Rookie Showmanship Classes will be held prior to Steer and Heifer Shows. All exhibitors (owners of steers or heifers in the show) will be eligible to participate in one of the classes. **Exhibitors must show their own calf.** Classes will consist of the following: Senior (Grades 10, 11, & 12), Junior (Grades 8 & 9) Novice (Grades 6 & 7) and Rookie (Grades 4 & 5). Showmanship classes will be placed 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>.
  8. **Homegrown calves** are steers or heifers whose dam was owned by the exhibitor, exhibitor's parent or grandparent at the time of the calf's birth. Should be non-purchased animals raised on farm of exhibitor, exhibitor's parent or grandparent. The Homegrown Heifer Class will be divided into Best Homegrown Registered Heifer and Best Homegrown Commercial Heifer. There will only be one placing in each class.

9. Any heifers or steers born in the six Mid-Georgia Cattlemen's Association's counties (Lamar, Monroe, Pike, Spalding, Talbot, or Upson) are eligible to show in the **Best Mid-Georgia Grown Steer and Best Mid-Georgia Grown Heifer Classes**. If the producer is a member of the Mid-Georgia Cattlemen's Association, there will be an additional \$25.00 premium paid to the winner. There will only be one placing in each class.
10. A contestant will be allowed to show a maximum of two steers in the steer division and/or three heifers in the heifer division. If a contestant has more than one animal in one class, only a 4-H or FFA member will be allowed to show the second animal for the contestant.
11. No substitute showman allowed for exhibitors that are not present at the show without prior approval of the West Central Show Committee. Any exhibitor that participates in a FFA or 4-H event that weekend will be allowed a substitute 4-H or FFA showman if the exhibitor sends a copy of the entry form for the other event.
12. Classes will be set at the discretion of the Classification Committee.
13. Any calf that shows unruliness may be disqualified by the Judge or Classification Committee.
14. No straw allowed in barn.
15. Failure to comply with all rules and regulations as set forth will result in forfeiture of any and all prize money.
16. All steers/heifers will be shown at the owner's risk. The Mid-Georgia Cattlemen's Association, County Agents, Agriculture Advisors, Upson-Lee School System, Upson-Lee FFA, or any committee members will not be liable for any accidents or injuries to participants, spectators, livestock or equipment.
17. An Old Timer's Showmanship Class will be held **after** the Heifer Show. Anyone not qualified to participate as a youth exhibitor is eligible to participate. A \$5.00 entry fee will be collected before the show. Money collected will be the prize money. There will be 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> Place winners.
