Show Rules: Entries Due JULY 7

1. The show will be open to all counties in Georgia. Classes are open to 4-H and FFA members through the 12th grade (plus pre- club age children in grades K-4)
2. This show is open to any breed or crossbred wether or doe.
3. Only wethers and does allowed. **NO BUCKS!**
4. All goats will be shown as market and by weight. Goats will be weighed by show officials and be divided into classes as equal as possible.
5. Goats must have their milk teeth. Goats showing either or both of the first pair of the permanent incisors will not be able to show.
6. All goats must be dehorned or have horns tipped.
- 7. You can enter up to five goats.**
- 8. All goats must be entered by a tag number.**
9. Each exhibitor may show one goat in showmanship. The goat shown must be entered in the show and owned and entered by the exhibitor.
10. Only show officials and exhibitors allowed in the show ring.
11. Entry fees are \$20.00 per goat. Entry fees are **NON-REFUNDABLE**.
12. The goats must have an official health certificate (health paper), according to the State Department of Agriculture Health Regulations.
- 13. Entry deadline line is July 7, 2016. Late entry fees are \$30.00 per goat.**
14. The Central Region Shootout Goat Show Committee reserves the right to review the rules and make changes if necessary. All decisions made by the Show Committee are final.
15. Exhibitors have the right to show to whatever style they wish.

16. Central Region Shootout Committee nor any of its affiliates accept any responsibility nor assume any risk for injury to the exhibitor or animal due to or resulting from participation in the Central Region Shootout.

17. Concessions will be available during the show provided by the Central Region FFA Area Officers. All Proceeds will go to fund the Central Region Officers Program of Activities.

18. Two Large areas are available to tie up animals but there are no separate pens available, however penning in trailer will be acceptable. Limited Electricity is available so feel free to bring generators.

19. The Show facility has been made available from the Fort Valley State University. Please help us thank them for allowing us to use the facility by picking up any trash and debris before you leave.

20. This show is formed for the potential development of children and growing their relationship with livestock and agriculture. The Show committee has the right to remove participants or patrons that do not share the same goals by their actions or attitudes.
