General

- The show is open to any Georgia 4-H or FFA exhibitor.
- Only wethers and does may be shown....NO BUCKS.
- Goats must be ear tagged and tag number must correspond with number on the entry form. They must also have milk teeth.
- An official Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (Health Certificate) with the individual animal identification number is required to show.
- There is no rule on bracing.
- Goats will be divided into market classes based on weight; there is no minimum weight requirement. There will be no re-weighing once the goat has left the scale area.
- The owner is responsible for the care and clean-up of his/her own goat(s).
- Shavings for bedding will be provided in the barn.
- As space is limited, please pen with your county.
- Exhibitors must show his/her animals in all classes unless permission is otherwise given by the show committee.
- **All Georgia 4-H and FFA State Livestock Show Rules and Regulations will be followed.**

Entry and Premiums

- Entry fee is \$20.00 per goat with a limit of five. **Completed entry form with payment must be postmarked or hand delivered to Gordon County Extension office by Friday, July 22, 2016; check should be made payable to Gordon County 4-H.**
- Entry fees are non-refundable.
- All premiums will be paid by check which will be issued during the week following the show date.
- Payout of market and showmanship classes will be based on the availability of funds and the number of goats entered in the show.

Exhibitors will be classified based on grade level as of August 2016.
