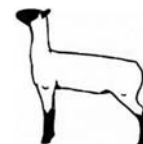

## General

- The show is open to any Georgia 4-H or FFA exhibitor.
- Entries must be wether or ewe lambs...NO RAMS.
- Lambs must be ear tagged and tag number must correspond with number on the entry form.
- An official Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (Health Certificate) with the individual animal identification number is required to show.
- Lambs will be divided into market classes based on weight; there is no minimum weight requirement. There will be no re-weighing once the lamb has left the scale area.
- An exhibitor can show up to four lambs, but cannot show more than two (2) in the same weight class. Shearing and/or clipping must be done outside of barn, weather permitting. All lamb entries must have their tails docked.
- Exhibitors are encouraged to show shorn slick lambs.
- The show committee reserves the right to mouth lambs should there be a question of age.
- The owner is responsible for the care and clean-up of his/her own lamb(s).
- The barn will be open on Friday, August 5th, 2016; however, official check-in starts at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, August 6, 2016 with the show beginning at 9:30 a.m. Have lambs freshly sheared (no more than two weeks growth). All lambs will be inspected for Club Lamb Fungus and Sore Mouth before weigh-in by a veterinarian from the State Department of Agriculture. Current health papers must be made available upon request.
- Shavings for bedding will be provided in the barn.
- As space is limited, please pen with your county.
- Exhibitors must show his/her animals in all classes unless permission is otherwise given by the show committee.
- **All Georgia 4-H and FFA State Livestock Show Rules and Regulations will be followed.**

## Entry and Premiums

- Entry fee is \$20.00 per lamb with a limit of four. **Completed entry form with payment must be postmarked or hand delivered to Gordon County Extension office by Friday, July 22, 2016; check should be made payable to Gordon County 4-H.**
- Entry fees are Non-Refundable.
- All premiums will be paid by check which will be issued during the week following the show date.
- Premiums will be based on the amount of entries received. Sponsored by North Georgia EMC, Grand Champions will receive \$100.00 and a belt buckle; Reserve Champions will receive \$50.00 and a belt buckle.
- Showmanship Classes:  
Exhibitors will be classified based on grade level as of August 2016.

- Market Classes:  
Lambs will be divided in class by weight.
- There will be no pee-wee class.
