1. Goats will be weighed by show officials at check-in.
2. Entries are open to all youth, 1<sup>st</sup> -12<sup>th</sup> grade.
3. The exhibitor on the entry form must be present to show the animal. Substitutions of exhibitor can only be made if the exhibitor has 2 animals in the same weight class.
4. Exhibitors must show their own goat in showmanship.
5. Goats may be brought in on Friday night at the owner's risk. You will pick your own pens as you arrive (first come, first served). You may put however many goats per pen as needed.
6. This show is open to any breed or crossbred, wether or doe. **Each goat must have an ear tag.** This tag can be any number the exhibitor chooses, but must match the number on the entry form.
7. Goats will be weighed divided into weight classes as equal in number as possible. Approximately 5-7 classes in each division. **Goats must weigh a minimum of 35 pounds to be eligible.**
8. Each exhibitor may enter a maximum of 3 goats as long as space is not limited (show chairman reserves right to limit numbers after entries come in).
9. All goats must be carrying all milk teeth at the time of check-in. Goats showing either or both of the first pair of permanent incisors will not be eligible to show.
10. All goats must be dehorned or have horns tipped.
11. There will be four classes of goat showmanship. Class 1 (Pre-club) will consist of exhibitors 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> grade, Class 2 (Cloverleaf) will consist of exhibitors in 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grade, Class 3 (Junior) will consist of exhibitors in 7<sup>th</sup> through 9<sup>th</sup> grade, and Class 4 (Senior) will consist of exhibitors in 10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade.
12. Health Requirements: Must have current Georgia health papers.
13. Exhibitors have the freedom to show the style of their choice.
14. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning their own pens following the show.
