

## *1<sup>st</sup> Annual Georgia Elite Wether Dam Show*

1. The show is open to 4-H and FFA members. All 4-H and FFA members through the 12th grade (plus pre-club age children in grades K-4) may show.
2. Only does allowed.
3. Goats will be weighed and divided into classes of at least ten goats per class by show officials.
4. Classes: Exhibitors must show their own goat in class. If the exhibitor has more than one goat in class they can have another exhibitor show for them. This must be cleared with show officials before showing.
5. All goats must be dehorned or have horns tipped.
6. All goats must be properly ear tagged.
7. **Entry Fee: The entry per animal is \$20.** Late entries will be **\$40.00** if received after February 1.
8. Goats must have milk teeth. Goats showing evidence of any of their permanent incisors will not be allowed to show.
9. A certificate of Veterinary Inspection is required with the individual identification and the following statement: **Flock of origin is free from Foot Rot, Scabies, Contagious Ecthyma(soremouth), Cutaneous Fungal Lesions, Scrapie or any other Infectious disease.** All Does must have a USDA approved scrapie tag in the ear. **Registration numbers will not serve as the scrapie tag for the show.**
10. The Georgia Elite Wether Dam Show Committee reserves the right to review the rules and make changes if necessary. All decisions made by the Georgia Elite Wether Dam Show Committee are final.
11. Absolutely no refunds will be given.
12. There are no weight limits.
13. The Georgia Elite Wether Dam Show Committee accepts no responsibility nor assumes any risk for injury to the exhibitor or animal due to or resulting from participation in the Georgia Elite Wether Dam Show.
