Youth Small Ruminant Day

What: A workshop designed to educate youth that raise and/or show small ruminants. The majority of the day will be devoted to becoming certified in FAMACHA, a diagnostic test to identify small ruminants that may or may not need deworming. Those age 16 and up will receive a FAMACHA© card and certificate for completing the training! We will also have a session on small ruminant nutrition.
