



Mellow on the Yellow Lamb and Goat Classic Rules and Guidelines



1. The show is open to 4-H (including pre-club) and FFA members.
2. All Georgia 4-H and FFA State Livestock Rules and Regulations will be followed.
 - Exception is that you can show all five goats at the show, whereas, at State you are allowed to show three.
3. Only wethers and does allowed. NO BUCKS. All animals will be shown as market.
4. Animal will be weighed and divided into classes by show officials.
 - After the Animal leaves the scales there will be no re-weighs.
5. Classes: Exhibitors must show their own goat in class. If the exhibitor has more than one goat in class they can have another exhibitor show for them.
 - This must be cleared with show officials before showing.
6. Does and wethers will be shown together.
7. Showmanship: Each exhibitor must show their own animal in showmanship. The animal must be entered in the show and owned by the exhibitor.
8. All goats must be dehorned or have horns tipped.
9. This show will allow bracing.
10. All goats must be ear tagged with state identification tags.
11. **Entry Fee: The entry fee per animal is \$25.**
 - Late entries will be charged an additional \$10.00 if postmarked after August 1st.
12. Showmanship prize will be awarded based on the number of entries per class. Amount of prize money is based on entries.
13. Payouts will be for the following:
 - Top 5 individuals in weight classes along with Grand and Reserve in weight
 - Showmanship prize will be awarded Belt Buckle for Champion and prize for top five in each division.
14. Due to the limited space, pens will be assigned on a first come first served basis. The show committee reserves the right to ask you to house your animal on your trailer if we run out of pen space.
 - Unapproved Pen alterations are not allowed.
 - There will be at least 2 goats per pen.
15. A certificate of Veterinary Inspection is required with the individual identification and the following statement:

Flock of origin is free from Foot Rot, Scabies, Contagious Ecthyma (soremouth), Cutaneous Fungal Lesions, Scrapie or any other Infectious disease.
All Does must have a USDA approved scrapie tag in the ear.
Registration numbers will not serve as the scrapie tag for the show.
16. The Newton County FFA Chapters reserve the right to review the rules and make changes if necessary. All decisions made by the Newton County FFA Chapters are final.
17. Absolutely no refunds will be given.
18. There are no weight limits.
19. Weigh in will be Saturday, August 12th
 - Lambs will weigh in from 7:00am - 8:30am
 - Goats will weigh in from 10:00am - 11:30am

20. Barns will open at 6:00pm on Friday, August 11th and close at 8:00pm and reopen at 6:00am on Saturday, August 12th.
21. The Lamb show will start at 9:00am and the Goat Show will start 30 minutes after the lamb show OR no earlier than 12:00pm.
22. The Newton County FFA accepts no responsibility nor assumes any risk for injury to the exhibitor or animal due to or resulting from participation in the Yellow on the Mellow.
