Apple Capital Market Goat Show

August 12, 2017

1. Show will be held at the new state of the art, air conditioned Gilmer County Agriculture Education Center located at 385 Clear Creek School Road in Ellijay, Georgia 30536.
2. The Show is open to 4-H and FFA members.
3. All Georgia 4-H and FFA State Livestock Rules and Regulations will be followed.
4. Only Wethers and Does Allowed. **NO BUCKS**. All animals will be shown as market.
5. **Weigh In:** After the goat leaves the scales there will be no additional weigh in without show official consent.
Weigh in begins Saturday, August 12th from 6 a.m. to 9 a.m.
6. Goats will be weighed and divided into classes of eight to twelve (8-12) goats per class as equal in number as possible. (Number of classes may vary depending on the number of entries and the show official's discretion).
7. **Classes:** Exhibitors must show their own goat in class. If the exhibitor has more than one goat in a class, they can have another exhibitor show for them. This must be cleared with show officials before showing.
8. The show will be split into a doe show and wether show.
9. All goats must be dehorned or have horns tipped.
10. Goats must be carrying all milk teeth at time of weight-in. Goats showing either or both of the first pair of permanent incisors will not be eligible to show.
11. All goats must be ear tagged with state identification tags.
12. **Showmanship:** Each exhibitor must show their own animal in showmanship. The animal must be entered in the show and owned by the exhibitor. (Oldest Class (12th grade) will show first beginning at 9:30 a.m.)
13. Due to the limited space, pens will be assigned on a first come first served basis with approximately 120 pens available. (The show committee reserves the right to ask you to house your animal on your trailer if we run out of pen space.) Counties may have to share pens. Pen Alterations are not allowed. There will be at least 2 goats per pen.
14. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspections is required with the individual identification and the following statement: **FLOCK OF ORGIN IS FREE FROM FOOT ROT, SCABIES, CONTAGIOUS ECTHYMA (SOREMOUTH), CUTANEOUS FUNGAL LESIONS, SCRAPIE, And/or ANY OTHER INFECTIOUS DISEASE**. Any visible sick animal will be asked to leave the premises.
15. All Does must have a USDA approved scrapie tag in the ear. Registration numbers will not serve as the scrapie tag for the show.
16. **Entry Fee:** The entry fee per animal is \$20. Late entries fee will be charged an additional \$5.00 per animal/per exhibitor. Money will be used for prize money after expenses are removed. Amount of prize money is based on entries and is subject to change*:
Payouts will be for the following:
Top 5 Does and Top 5 Wethers
Top 5 Individuals in Classes (market classes and showmanship)
17. The Gilmer County FFA reserves the right to review the rule and make changes if necessary. All decisions made by the Gilmer County FFA are final.
18. No alcoholic beverages or weapons on school premises are allowed any violators will be asked to leave immediately.
