ENTRY INFORMATION

Please note this year's location above. All changes are highlighted.

1. Show is open to current FFA and 4H members from Georgia and Florida students in counties touching or North of I-10
- Exhibitors must meet age requirements of Georgia State Livestock Show. **Age Requirements** a. State Market Hog, Steer, Heifer, and Commercial Dairy Heifer Shows - An exhibitor must be in the 4th grade or older on September 1, 2017 and cannot have completed high school.
- Entry fee of \$25 per head of cattle. Make checks payable to: *Titletown Showdown Cattle Show*.
- Entry forms and fees **must be postmarked no later Saturday, November 11th**. Entry forms may be obtained from Agriculture Education Teachers and Extension Agents. **Late entries will be accepted for an additional fee of \$10.**
- Show limited to total of 85 head of show cattle. If entries exceed 85 head, show eligibility will be determined by postmark date.
6. Exhibitors are limited to two heifers and two steers.
- Steers will be shown by weight. Heifers will be shown by a registered division, date of birth. Registered heifers will be classed and shown in an English, Continental, and Brahm division. Commercial heifer division will show by weight. Supreme Champion heifer picked from Champion Commercial and Champion Registered of each registered division.
- Showmanship will be divided by current grade in school. Youth 4th – 6th, junior 7th – 9th, and Senior 10th – 12th.
9. PEE WEE SHOWMANSHIP- Children age 5 – 8 can participate in showmanship class for age group. Can show animal of another exhibitor registered in show or own animal. Exhibitor must be accompanied in ring by adult. Entry fee of \$10. Exhibitors of this age group can only show in this showmanship division only and not in regular animal classes.
- Calves must meet the age requirements of the Georgia State Livestock Show. **Heifers must be born on or after January 1, 2016. Steers must be born after August 1, 2016.**
- Georgia Junior Livestock Shows Rules and Eligibility apply unless specified.
- All animals must be clearly identified with tattoo or ear tag.
- All exhibits will comply with Georgia Health requirements and have current health documents to be eligible for the Show.
14. Cattle Show is a "No Fit" Show. No adhesives or paint except for hooves.
- Suggest bring generators – electrical availability is limited.**
- Any disputes subject to final decision the Titletown Showdown Committee
- All exhibitors will receive prize money for placing in animal classes. Special awards will be given to the Top 5 steers and heifers, as well as Champion in each division of showmanship.
- Concession stand will be available for food on Saturday.
