General Rules

1. Show is open to any 4H or FFA member and previous 4H or FFA member that has graduated but less than 21 years old in the following Counties.
 - Banks, Elbert, Franklin, Hart, Lincoln, Madison, Oglethorpe, Stephens, Wilkes
2. There will be a limit of 3 animals per exhibitor.
3. The first **150** pigs will be accepted.
4. Pens will be assigned to Exhibitors.
5. Showing off of a trailer will not be allowed.
6. Entry for Gilts and Barrows only. Gilts and Barrows will be shown together.
7. All pigs will be shown as market animals.
8. Maximum weight will be 225lb per pig, no variances allowed.
9. Each exhibitor must show his/her own animal unless the exhibitor has more than one animal in the same class. Must be cleared with show officials before showing.
10. All animals will be shown at the owner's risk. Each exhibitor must assume responsibility in the case of death or injury.
11. No straw bedding allowed.
12. No clipping at the show.
13. All animals must have a clean and readable ear tag.
14. All animals must have current health papers at time of unloading. All animals must be PRV and Brucellosis negative and have an official health certificate.
15. There will be no re-weighs after the animal leaves the scale area.
16. The judge's decision is final in all classes.
17. Show officials reserve the right to make changes deemed to be in the best interest of the show.
18. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on school property nor will the use of tobacco products be allowed. The Hart County Agriscience Center is a school owned facility and all school rules / laws apply.
