

2nd Annual Georgia Elite Wether Dam Shows
2 Shows- 2 Judges-1 Location-1 Day-1 EntryFee

This livestock event will be TWO wether dam shows for each breeding does and breeding ewes. We will begin with the breeding doe show at 9:00, showmanship followed by weight classes, and then begin the breeding ewe show, showmanship followed by weight classes. At the completion of the first show, we will have a short break, and begin the second show with a different judge using the same order.

1. The show is open to 4-H and FA members. All 4-H and FFA members through the 12th grade (plus pre-club age children in grades K-4) may show.
2. Only breeding does or breeding ewes allowed.
3. **Barn will open and weigh in from 4:00-7:00 on Friday and 6:00-8:00 Saturday morning. The show will begin at 9:00 with showmanship.**
4. Does and ewes will be weighed and divided into classes of at least ten does/ewes per class by show officials.
5. Classes: Exhibitors must show their own doe/ewe in class. If the exhibitor has more than one doe/ewe in class they can have another exhibitor show for them. This must be cleared with show officials before showing.
6. All does must be dehorned or have horns tipped.
7. All does/ewes must be properly ear tagged.
8. **Entry Fee: The entry per animal is \$40. Late entries will be \$60.00 if received after December 15th.**
9. A certificate of Veterinary Inspection is required with the individual identification and the following statement: **Flock of origin is free from Foot Rot, Scabies, Contagious Ecthyma(soremouth), Cutaneous Fungal Lesions, Scrapie or any other Infectious disease. All Does must have a USDA approved scrapie tag in the ear. Registration numbers will not serve as the scrapie tag for the show.**
10. The Georgia Elite Wether Dam Show Committee reserves the right to review the rules and make changes if necessary. All decisions made by the Georgia Elite Wether Dam Show Committee are final.
11. Absolutely no refunds will be given.
12. There are no weight limits.
13. The Georgia Elite Wether Dam Show Committee accepts no responsibility nor assumes any risk for injury to the exhibitor or animal due to or resulting from participation in the Georgia Elite Wether Dam Show.
