1. Pens will be assigned first come, first serve. Pigs may be shown off the trailer and all trailers must be set up in the designated trailer areas.
2. Penning will be a minimum of two pigs per pen.
3. No pens will be allowed to be used for tack.
4. All pigs must have an official health certificate.
5. No limit to the number of animals you can show.
6. All pigs must have a readable ear tag.
7. Entries will be limited to 150 head.
8. Classes will be split based on weight. Classes will be broken with as many even number of entries as possible. Hogs will be shown lightest to heaviest.
9. There is no minimum weight for hogs, maximum weight is 275lbs.
10. Barrows and gilts will be shown together.
11. The judge's decision is final in all classes.
12. No clipping of pigs at the show.
13. There will be no reweighs after the pig leaves the weigh in area.
14. Payout will be determined upon number of entries.
15. Showmanship classes will be determined by entries. Show is open to all eligible students in 4-H and FFA.
16. The Newton County FFA Chapters and Newton County School System, its members, nor anyone or anybody associated with the show are not liable for accidents, injuries or theft.
17. Exhibitors are responsible for his or her own animal and property. All exhibitors assume all risk associated with this.
18. The barn will open on Friday, February 2nd at 4:30pm and will be closed at 9:00pm. The barn will be open on Saturday, February 3<sup>rd</sup> at 6:30am.
19. Weight-in will be from 5:00pm-8:00pm on February 2<sup>nd</sup> and 7:00am-9:00am on February 3<sup>rd</sup>. The show will begin at 10:00am on February 3<sup>rd</sup>.
20. Pigs will need to be dropped at the barn and trucks/trailers will then be parked at the baseball field. We will have shuttles to the barn, when needed.
21. Belt Buckles will be provided to all showmanship winners.

The Newton County FFA Livestock Show Team will have a concession stand open with home cooked items available for breakfast, lunch and snacks.
