Dear Coaches and Contestants:

The Auburn University Block and Bridle Club and the Department of Animal Sciences will be hosting a 4-H/FFA judging contest on Saturday, April 27, 2019. It will be held at the Stanley P. Wilson Beef Unit at 500 Shug Jordan Parkway on Auburn University's campus. Registration will begin at 8:00 a.m. and the contest will begin at 9:00 a.m.

Teams and individuals are welcome to participate in the contest. The contest will follow 4-H livestock judging rules. Each 4-H club, FFA chapter, county, school, and/or region may have an unlimited number of teams. There will be a Junior and Senior division. The Junior division is anyone ages 9-13 on January 1, 2019. The Senior division is anyone ages 14-18 on January 1, 2019. The species that will be judged are beef cattle, sheep or goats, and swine. There will be oral questions and reasons: Juniors will have one set of questions and one set of reasons. Seniors will have one set of questions and two sets of reasons. The officials will discuss placings at the completion of the contest and all contestants will be eligible to receive awards. At the conclusion of the contest, awards will be presented.

The entry fee is \$15.00 per contestant including coaches, which includes lunch. Entry forms should be postmarked on or before April 16, 2019. Any entry forms postmarked after April 16 will require a \$10.00 late fee, no exceptions. If not postmarked by this date please contact us to allow all contestants the opportunity to judge livestock.
