Dr. Jones led the development of the DSSAT crop modeling system along with others at UF and in other institutions. He was one of the principal developers of the Agricultural Model Intercomparison and Improvement Project (AgMIP), which is now led by Columbia University. As co-founder of the Florida Climate Institute, he served as director of the FCI unit until his retirement in 2011 and now serves on the Executive Board as Advisor.

Dr. Hoogenboom received his PhD at Auburn University in 1985 and prior to joining UF in 2016, he served as faculty at Washington State University and the University of Georgia. Dr. Hoogenboom's research focuses on the development of the crop simulation models and application of decision support systems for sustainable development, resource management, and food security. He is a core member of the Global Food Systems Institute at UF and leads the DSSAT (Decision Support System for Agrotechnology Transfer) modeling system.
